2015/389	Declarations	Cllr Stewart declared an interest as he is now a County Cllr at RCC on the Planning Committee and cannot pass comments on any Planning Applications.

2015/391	Matters Arising	There were no matters arising from the previous minutes	
2015/392	To receive Correspondence	Information regarding a pension scheme for the clerk, the Chair had received correspondence from MOPPA about the future of the play area. Chair to contact MOPPA.	
2015/393	To authorise Payments	All payments approved Clerks Salary for May and June £188.89 for both months. £42.21 for Cartridges, £652.60 to Cory's Environmental for Grass cutting.	
2015/394	To discuss Deputy Chair	Cllr Buff has been voted as Deputy Chair of the Parish Council.	
2015/395	To Discuss a Planning Committee	Due to a low numbers of Cllrs at the meeting it was decided to put this on next months Agenda	
2015/396	To receive Planning Applications Ref 2015/0410/FUL Erection of new three bed private dwelling and demolition of existing garage, 17a Bowling Green Lane, Market Overton.	Due to holidays and a bereavement the Parish Council could not form a Quorum to make any decision on the Planning Application, which the Chair gave apologies. The only concern that was raised was by the neighbour of the applicant was one of privacy. These concerns have been put in writing to RCC Planning Department and was hoped that the situation could be resolved between themselves.	
2015/397	To discuss the Village Stocks	The Chairman has contacted the village Handyman for him to repair the stocks.	
2015/398	To discuss the School Bus	The Chairman has spoken to Sarah Thomas who is the main contact for the village with reference to another location for the children to get the school bus. Several propositions have been put forward which need to be discussed further. Cllr Stewart has had a meeting at RCC re the School Bus escorts. It has been decided that a meeting with the all the Rutland villages at RCC would be helpful.	
2015/399	To discuss Dog Bins	As this has not progressed it has been decided to withdraw it from the Agenda.	
2015/400	To discuss Grass Verges	There have been several complaints that the verges are being destroyed. The Chairman will put a notice on the Website and in the Village Newsletter asking people to not park on the Village Grass Verges. .	
2015/401	To discuss Speeding Signs	Cllr Stewart contacted RCC Highways to ask about progress on the speeding signs for the village. It had been decided that the Parish Council will pay for one speeding sign to be installed and at a later date RCC will install another. These will be situated at either end of the village.
